Feedback from Parents' Forum meeting on Thursday 21st March

Dear Parents/Carers,

Thank you to all those parents who attended our parent forum meeting yesterday. It was, as ever, good to see so many parents interested in the developments within school and to share our plans going forward. I have attached to this letter a summary of the points discussed.

Two items were raised by parents. Firstly, a parent who could not attend the meeting asked whether there was any possibility for the school to run a breakfast club. This has happened in the past but was discontinued as it was not financially viable. However, to gauge interest in any potential future breakfast club I have attached a questionnaire to this letter where you can share your views.

Also, a parent mentioned the possibility of the school being involved with the Bretforton "Last Night of the Proms" in July. This would be a wonderful way for the school to be involved in another community event and we are currently looking into this.

Thank you once again for giving your time to talk to me – your involvement and interest in the school is very much appreciated. There will be another Parent Forum meeting in summer term – the date of this will be advised after the Easter holidays.

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Summary of points discussed at Parent Forum Meeting – 21st March 2019

Achievements

School Attendance is now at 97% (nationally measured as good)
Behaviour across the school has improved, as measured by the number of red letters issued to children and also the number of rewards issued for good behaviour.
The school has adopted policies from Bengeworth Multi-Academy Trust which ensure legal compliance.

A summary of the school's Challenge Partners review was shared with parents and the points discussed.

Communication

We discussed communication and how the school passed information to the parents. The general feeling was that communication continued to be good and parents appreciated the text messages reminders that were sent out. The regularity of the newsletters was popular.

Future developments

Read Write Inc

The school has developed its use of Red Write Inc as a means to delivering its phonics sessions. This involved a large amount of training in late autumn term. The results of this have already started to show, in pupils' confidence and ability to read.

Building project

The school has successfully bid for money to allow for some work to be done inside and outside of the school building.
The works will include

- replacement of two exterior doors
- reorganisation of the hall storage
- addition of a toilet with access from the Oak classroom
- moving the staffroom to the rainbow room to create two teaching areas

Once the work has been planned out, we will have a better idea of timescales and the impact on the school before and after the work but the intention is that all work will be carried out during the summer holidays to minimise disruption.
