Dear Parents/Carers,

In May, Year 2 children will be sitting national tests called SATs. I would therefore like to invite you to a KS1 SAT's presentation on Wednesday 1st May at 9.00am in Ash classroom. During this presentation, I will explain what SAT's are, which subjects are tested, how they are marked and what will happen to the results. I will also show some sample SAT's papers to give you an idea of what the tests involve. The presentation will last approximately 20-30 minutes.

The children do not need to practise SAT's papers at home as we are doing lots of practise in school. However, if you would like to help them prepare over the Easter holidays, then there are some excellent, fun websites that the children have enjoyed using in school to develop their maths and grammar skills.
