PARENTAL PERMISSION FOR CHILD'S USE OF SWIMMING GOGGLES

has my permission to wear the goggles I have provided during swimming lessons.

THE GOGGLES –

- 1) are of British Standard manufacture / have a well-known brand name. (DELETE AS APPROPRIATE)
- 2) have well-padded rims and no rough edges.

I HAVE TAUGHT MY CHILD THAT FOLLOWING SAFETY PROCEDURE AND I AM CONFIDENT THAT S/HE CAN CARRY THEM OUT:

- 1) Before use, rinse goggles in the pool (this helps to prevent misting up)
- 2) If, in use, the goggles fill up with water or mist up, remove them completely to clear.
- 3) To remove goggles ONLY ever PUSH them up and then off the top of the head.
- 4) NEVER PULL GOGGLES FORWARD so that they may fly back and cause serious eye injury.
- 5) Do NOT wear goggles in a crowded pool (this may lead to collision with the poolside or other swimmers).
- 6) Do NOT wear goggles when diving or plunging into the pool.

Accidents are caused by people who do not know the dangers of misusing goggles.

NEVER PULL GOGGLES AWAY FROM YOUR OWN EYES

NEVER INTERFERE WITH GOGGLES WORN BY ANYONE ELSE

I understand that because of the hazard it represents, the practice of wearing goggles for swimming is not supported by the school.

I therefore undertake to accept full responsibility for any resultant misadventure.
