Transition arrangements for Year 5 pupils

Dear Parents,

As your child will be transferring from Bretforton Village School to Blackminster Middle School in September, we thought it might be helpful to reassure you that transition arrangements are moving forward to ensure as smooth as possible a process, given the current circumstances.

Over the coming weeks, we will be sharing information with Blackminster to ensure that they know your child as well as possible and that any inclusion needs have been shared with them. They have asked if we would send through any information about any friends (at Bretforton or other local schools) who they would like to be in a form group with. If you could let us know this information, we will pass it on for you.

Ordinarily, the children would be given a transition booklet in school that they complete before their arrival at Blackminster. This year, the booklet will be emailed out to you to complete with your child. If necessary, paper copies of this can be made available once it has arrived in school.

Blackminster are also in the process of putting together a Year 5 Transition page on their website for their new arrivals and their families. This will contain as much useful information as possible to make sure that children are prepared for the start of their time at Blackminster.

I appreciate that this is a time of anxiety for some children and the current situation has made this worse, however, I hope that this letter provides some reassurance that we are working closely with Blackminster to make things as straightforward as possible.
