Topic – Mexico!

<p>Writing We will develop our handwriting as well as our understanding of the punctuation we have learnt so far. We will learn how to plan, edit and evaluate our writing. We will carry out a range of short and extended writes linked to our writing topic 'Traditional Tales'.</p>	<p>Reading We will read and reread books to build our fluency. We will learn to retell traditional tales, recognising simple, recurring literary language as we do. We will take part in discussions about what we have read, taking turns and listening to others. We will use dictionaries to find the meanings of new words. We will listen to a range of traditional tales, as well as some of the 'Revolt Rhymes' written by our class author Roald Dahl.</p>	<p>Maths We will learn about the place value of 2 and 3-digit numbers, including reading, writing, comparing and ordering them. We will learn to recall number bonds, add and subtract 2 and 3-digit numbers and solve problems including missing number problems.</p>
<p>Science We will begin to investigate forces - in particular how things move on different surfaces. We will carry out simple experiments to test friction, making predictions about what we think will happen before testing our predictions.</p>	<p>RE We will explore what Christians can learn from the creation story.</p>	<p>Spelling, punctuation and grammar We will revisit the common exception words for Years 1 and 2. When we are very confident with these, we will go on to learn the common exception words for Years 3 and 4.</p>
<p>Computing We will learn about online safety, in particular learning rules to keep us safe when using the internet and how we share information safely.</p>	<p>Art and Design We will learn about the art work of Mexican artist Frida Kahlo. We will learn about her painting style and how her art tells us about her culture. We will learn how to create different facial expressions when drawing or painting portraits.</p>	<p>PE We will take part in a variety of invasion games.</p>
<p>Music We will learn to perform simple rhythmic patterns when playing an instrument, keeping a steady pulse. We will listen to music by Mexican musicians Rodrigo y Gabriela.</p>	<p>PSHE and Values We will explore the theme of friendship and what makes a good friend.</p>	<p>Geography We will learn about the differences in human and physical geography between a small place in Mexico and a small area of the UK.</p>



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
