Preventative Measures During the Pandemic from Monday 2nd November

23rd October 2020

Dear Parents/Carers,

As you may have read in the press or seen on the internet, the advice from Public Health England regarding face coverings has been revised recently. The new advice recommends that face coverings should be worn where it is physically difficult for parents to follow 2 metre social distancing rules.

This extra measure is being introduced to keep the whole school community safe, especially those who are most vulnerable.

Dr Kathryn Cobain, Director of Public Health at Worcestershire County Council, said: "I'd like to ask for the support of parents and carers to keep to the social distancing guidelines at all times, when dropping off and picking up your children. We strongly advise wearing a face-covering if you're unable to keep apart, by doing this you can help prevent the spread of the virus. Let's continue our hard work and remain in the lowest tier of measures."

As a school, we are operating as one "bubble" and in order to keep the school open, it is vital that the possibility of the spread of Covid is kept to a minimum. We would therefore ask that parents respect this request and wear face coverings at all times when on school premises (inside and out) from Monday 2nd November. Please note – this guidance does NOT apply to children.
