Guidance for Children attending Bretforton Village School during lockdown

Timekeeping

Your child should arrive at school no earlier than 8.50am and no later than 9.00am. The main gate will be unlocked at 8.50am and all children will be entering the building through the Year 2/3 entrance. Please maintain social distancing on arrival and ensure that you are wearing a mask.

Collection will be at 3.00pm from the playground as usual. We will NOT be using the Year 4/5 exit door. Please can we ask you to be prompt as it is our intention to vacate the building as quickly as possible to enable cleaning to take place safely.

If your child is not attending on any day for any reason, please can you let us know by emailing the school office.

Uniform

Your child should be in full school uniform each day. As your child is attending school as part of their education (not childcare), it is our expectation that their attendance is the same as an ordinary school day.

PE Kits

Your child will need their PE kit in school during the week as there may be PE sessions.

Lunch, milk and fruit

Please make sure your child has a packed lunch with them each day. If the option for hot lunches from Blackminster becomes available, we will let you know. Fruit and milk will not be delivered to school so please ensure your child has a snack and water bottle with them.

Behaviour

Our expectations in terms of behaviour are unchanged from a usual school day. Additionally, if a child's behaviour puts other children at risk in terms of transmission of Covid 19 (e.g. spitting), we may refuse to allow your child to attend, regardless of Critical Worker status.

Learning

Your child will be following the same learning that children accessing remote learning will follow. The groups will be organised initially as Reception and Year 1 together, and Years 2 through 5 together.
