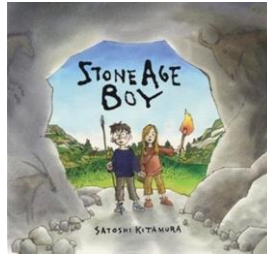




Termly Planning Overview- Dolphin class - summer 1 2021

Topic – Stone Age Boy



<p>Writing Our main text type will be historical narratives, with a focus on the story 'Stone Age Boy' by Satoshi Kitamura. We will learn about the key features of this text type, and through role play will develop ideas for our own Stone Age settings and characters. We will also learn how to proofread and edit our writing.</p>	<p>Reading Our key text will be 'Stone Age Boy' by Satoshi Kitamura. In guided reading sessions, we will develop our ability to retrieve information and make inferences about characters' thoughts and feelings. We will continue to listen to stories by our class author Roald Dahl.</p>	<p>Maths This term, Year 2s will cover position and direction and time and Year 3s will cover fractions, learning about tenths and how to add and subtract fractions. Both year groups will also learn about mass, volume and capacity through practical activities using measuring equipment.</p>
<p>Science Our topic in Science will be 'rocks'. We will learn how to classify different types of rock.</p>	<p>RE We will explore the question: What does it mean to belong to a faith community?</p>	<p>Spelling, punctuation and grammar We will continue to learn homophones and new spellings rules. Year 3s will practise using inverted commas and how to choose 'a' or 'an'. Year 2s will learn how to use apostrophes for contractions.</p>
<p>Computing We will develop our digital literacy and learn to take and use photographs.</p>	<p>Art We will learn to use clay to make a pot and 'Stone Age' jewellery, as well as making our own cave paintings.</p>	<p>PE We will take part in athletics activities.</p>
<p>French We will learn how to count and read numbers in French.</p>	<p>PSHE and Values In PSHE, we will explore the different types of jobs that people do. Our value for this half term is forgiveness and we will be exploring this throughout the term through circle time activities in class.</p>	<p>History We will learn about how Britain changed between the beginning of the Stone Age and the Iron Age, the main differences between Stone, Bronze and Iron Age, as well as what is meant by 'hunter gatherers'.</p>
