Early Morning and After-School provision from September

Wednesday 14th July 2021

Dear Parents/Carers,

You will know from previous letters that we have been finalising arrangements for the early morning provision that was requested by parents. I am pleased to provide you with the following information which lays out the details of this, and also confirms details for the after-school provision from September.

Early Morning Provision – Monday to Friday 7.45am to school opening time

From Wednesday 8th September (first day of term), we will be open from 7.45am for those children who have booked and paid for places using the ParentPay system. Each session will cost £4.50 per child, regardless of the time that they arrive. (e.g. there is no reduction if your child arrives at 8.15am). A small breakfast of cereal, fruit and/or toast will be provided. Please note – if your child has special dietary requirements, it will be your responsibility to provide their food and if your child arrives after 8.15am, their food choices will be limited by what is still available.

All Early Morning Provision bookings **MUST** be made by midnight the day before the session. For staffing reasons, we cannot take last-minute bookings and will not accept children arriving early who have not been booked in. **Bookings open on 1st September.**

After-school provision – Monday to Thursday 3.00pm - 4.30pm

This will continue as before but, owing to rising costs, the price from September will be £4.50 per child per session. This will also begin on Wednesday 8th September and can be booked on ParentPay.

The deadline for After-School Provision bookings remains at 10.00am each day.

While we hope that our Early Morning Provision is successful, I do need parents to be aware that this is currently a trial scheme and we will be reviewing it at the end of autumn term.
