Egg Allergy in School

Dear Parents/Carers,

As you are aware, I have written to you previously alerting you to the fact that we have children in school who have nut allergies, and the importance of making sure that you do not send your child into school with any product that may contain nuts.

I need to also make you aware that we have a child in school who has an allergy to raw eggs and products containing raw eggs. Although this may seem an easy one to avoid, you do need to be aware that boiled eggs, mayonnaise, some salad creams and other dressings may contain raw eggs and therefore should not be brought into school.

Additionally, it is essential that you reinforce the message to your child that they should not share ANY of their food with other children, or ask to share other children's as this can lead to problems for those children who are either allergic or intolerant of certain foods.

I appreciate that this limits choices for some children but I am sure that you understand that this is to keep children in school as safe as possible.
