

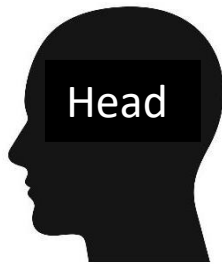


## Mallard Class - Year 4 and 5

We will learn about the birth of the Industrial Revolution.  
We will develop an understanding of biographies.  
We will identify the key features of biographies.  
We will understand the differences between biographies and autobiographies.  
We will read a range of biographies.  
We will learn methods to multiply and divide efficiently.  
We will learn about forces and gravity.  
We will learn how faith can influence a person's decisions.  
We will learn about coding.  
We will learn the French words for different types of weather.  
We will learn about Andy Warhol and his style of painting.  
We will learn strategies to help someone who needs First Aid.



We will continue to develop positive learning attitudes.  
We will learn to identify how we are feeling.  
We will consider why a person's faith can influence how they want to make the world a better place.  
We will develop an understanding of staying calm in a stressful situation.  
We will develop an understanding of why children were affected during the Industrial Revolution.  
We will consider how the Industrial Revolution had an impact on life in the UK.
